- 1. APOLOGIES & WELCOME: The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting, apologies for absence were received from Cllr Youngman and Cllr Lightfoot.
- 2. MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF 15 JANUARY 2018: The minutes of the meeting held on 15 January 2018 were accepted and approved and signed as a true record

- a. CRIME, VANDALISM & ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR: There were no reports or updates.
- b. COUNCILLOR'S UPDATES: It was reported that ponies were grazing on the public footpath on the Trent bank, Clerk to speak to WLDC.
- c. LORRIES ACCESSING FERTILISER LAGOON: Cllr Panter reported that he had visited the site with Cllr Keyes from Gainsborough Town Council and felt that the small amount of damage to the roadside could have been done by tractors as well as any lorries accessing the site. It was gareed to remove the item from future gaenda.
- d. SID SIGNAGE / CROSSING NEAR TO CO-OP: Correspondence was received regarding the Community Speed Watch which should be in operation by the Summer. Cllr Allison has money available via his WLDC Councillor Initiative Funding towards the purchase Clerk of an electronic sign. Clerk to obtain quotes for this.

#### **NEW ITEMS / CORRESPONDENCE:** 5.

- a. BUS SHELTER ON WALKERITH ROAD: Correspondence had been received from a resident requesting that the Parish Council give some thought to having the present bus shelter replaced with a shelter fit for purpose. The present concrete shelter gives little shelter and the roof overhang is leaking. Clerk to contact LCC

- **b.** AGE UK LINDSEY: It was resolved to send £50 donation to AGE UK Lindsey.
- **NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING:** There is no current Neighbourhood Planning committee in 6. Morton. There has been little interest from the community. It was reported that WLDC intend to start promoting this initiative again, and will target eligible villages. There was a discussion about how to promote this within the village, it was agreed that this does need to be a community-led programme.

The School had informed the Clerk that the Football Club had left the changing rooms in a bad condition; Cllr Butroid will inform Cllr Lightfoot.
